Background

Produces a compliance guide on banned, refused and restricted-use pesticides — how to keep your range clean, check registration/label status, handle phase-outs and restricted-use conditions, and avoid illegal stock. Use it to stay legal on product selection. For overall pesticide law use the Insecticides Act Compliance Guide.

Purpose of this tool & output

Avoid banned and restricted agrochemicals

How the output is used

Use it to keep banned and restricted agrochemicals off your shelves — a check against the current CIB&RC banned/restricted list before you stock or sell.

Important cautions

The list of banned, refused, restricted and phased-out pesticides changes by government notification — selling any is a serious offence. Verify the current registration/ban status of every product and audit your shelf regularly. Confirm the latest CIB notifications and banned list.
