

Agri-Input Dealership Setup Guide

Agri-Inputs & Farm Supply

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a setup plan for an agri-input retail/dealership business — product focus, licences, shop and godown, company tie-ups and a launch checklist. Use it to start out. For the full plan use the Agri-Input Business Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

Start a seed, fertilizer and pesticide shop

How the output is used

Use it as your first roadmap to open an input shop — settle the product focus, line up the licences and tie-ups, then move to the full plan for funding.

Important cautions

Selling seed, fertilizer and pesticide each needs its own licence (Seeds Act, FCO, Insecticides Act), and the pesticide licence usually needs an agricultural qualification or DAESI certificate. Confirm current licence and qualification requirements with the district agriculture officer.
