Background

Produces a fertilizer range plan — the core NPK, complexes, micronutrients and specialty/water-solubles to stock for local crops and soils, with demand and subsidy notes. Use it to plan fertilizer stock. For DBT/subsidy operations use the DBT Compliance guide.

Purpose of this tool & output

Stock the right fertilizers and micronutrients

How the output is used

Use it to stock the right fertilizer and micronutrient range for your soils and crops — from urea and DAP to complexes, water-solubles and micronutrients.

Important cautions

Stock micronutrients for locally proven deficiencies and align to the crop nutrient calendar. Subsidised fertilizers must be sold via DBT/PoS at notified rates. Recommend a soil-test-based approach — avoid pushing unneeded products. Confirm current subsidy/NBS rules.
