Background

Produces a storage/godown setup plan for an agri-input dealer — layout, safe separate pesticide storage, fertilizer/seed conditions, safety and legal norms. Use it to store stock safely and legally. For pesticide safety specifics use the Pesticide Storage & Safety tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Set up compliant, safe input storage

How the output is used

Use it to set up compliant, safe storage — separate, ventilated pesticide storage away from seed and fertilizer, with the layout inspectors expect.

Important cautions

The Insecticides Rules require pesticides to be stored separately, ventilated and away from food/feed, with safety measures. Poor fertilizer/seed storage causes caking and germination loss. Confirm current storage and display norms with the agriculture/licensing authority.
