

Quality Liability Protection Guide

Agri-Inputs & Farm Supply

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a liability-protection plan for an input dealer — how genuine sourcing, documentation, labelling and records shield you when a product fails or is sampled, and where dealer liability really lies across seed, fertilizer and pesticide. Use it to limit legal exposure. For inspections use the Inspection Readiness tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Protect yourself from input-quality liability

How the output is used

Use it to protect yourself from input-quality liability — buy only from authorised sources, keep bills and source certificates, and sell within the label so a failure is the company liability, not yours.

Important cautions

Your legal shield is selling only genuine, source-certified, registered, labelled, in-date product with full documentation, correct storage, and on-label advice — that keeps a manufacturing defect the maker liability, not yours. Misbranding, expired/banned sales, mishandling or off-label advice are your liability. For any actual dispute or prosecution, consult a lawyer.
