Background

Produces safe-use guidance for farmers buying pesticides — correct dose/mixing, PPE, spraying precautions, pre-harvest and re-entry intervals, storage and disposal, and poisoning first-aid. Use it to counsel farmers responsibly at the counter. For dealer-side storage safety use the Pesticide Storage & Safety Compliance tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Advise farmers on safe pesticide use

How the output is used

Use it to advise farmers on safe pesticide use — dose, protective gear, spraying precautions, re-entry and disposal — as a farmer-facing safety kit.

Important cautions

Pesticides are toxic — always advise farmers to follow the label, use protective gear, respect pre-harvest/re-entry intervals, and never reuse containers. In case of poisoning, seek immediate medical help. This is general safety guidance; the product label and a doctor are the authorities.
