

Spurious & Counterfeit Input Detection

Agri-Inputs & Farm Supply

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a plan to detect and avoid spurious/counterfeit inputs — sourcing safeguards, packaging/label/genuineness checks, red flags, and protecting yourself from liability. Use it to keep fakes off your shelf. For supplier vetting use the Supplier Selection tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Keep fake seed, fertilizer and pesticide out

How the output is used

Use it to keep fake seed, fertilizer and pesticide out of your shop — source checks, packaging and batch verification that protect both farmers and your liability.

Important cautions

Spurious/counterfeit inputs are a serious offence and liability — source only from authorised companies/distributors with full documentation, check labels/seals/registration, and reject suspiciously cheap or paperless deals. Genuine-source documentation protects you if a genuine product later fails. Report spurious supply to authorities.
