Background

Builds a diversification plan for an aviation business — adjacent lines like MRO, training, ground handling, FBO, drones or cargo that leverage existing assets, approvals and expertise. Use it to spread risk and use assets better.

Purpose of this tool & output

Diversify into adjacent aviation lines

How the output is used

Use it to diversify into adjacent aviation lines — charter to cargo, training to services, or into drones — using what you already have.

Important cautions

Diversify into lines that genuinely leverage your assets, approvals and expertise and each new line brings its own approvals and safety obligations. Validate demand and approval feasibility and never let diversification dilute core safety oversight.
