

Flying Training Organisation (FTO) Setup

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a setup plan for a flying training organisation — base airfield, fleet, instructors, DGCA approval, curriculum and safety — to train pilots. Use it as the playbook to establish an FTO.

Purpose of this tool & output

Set up a DGCA-approved flying school

How the output is used

Use it to set up a DGCA-approved flying school — the base, fleet, instructors, curriculum and infrastructure an FTO needs.

Important cautions

FTO approval, base and airspace, fleet and instructor requirements are exacting and safety-critical and take time; training safety is paramount. Confirm the current FTO requirements with DGCA and prioritise safety and instructor quality.
