Use it to cut fuel burn and cost — the operational, weight and routing measures that reduce the biggest variable cost in flying.

Important cautions

Fuel is the dominant variable cost and exposed to price and forex volatility; tankering and hedging have limits and risks. Verify station prices and hedging suitability and never compromise required fuel reserves for economy.
