Background

Builds a parts and stores management plan — traceability and certification, storage and shelf-life, inventory and AOG (aircraft-on-ground) response, and bogus-parts prevention. Use it to run an airworthy, efficient stores.

Purpose of this tool & output

Manage parts, traceability and AOG

How the output is used

Use it to manage parts, traceability and AOG response — stores control, certification records and quick turnaround when an aircraft is grounded.

Important cautions

Parts traceability and airworthiness certification are safety-critical and unapproved or bogus parts are illegal and dangerous. Accept only certified, traceable parts and follow your approved stores procedures and CARs.
