Background

Produces a setup plan for an aviation business — segment, DGCA and other approvals, assets and a phased roadmap. Use it to start out. For a funding document use the Aviation Business Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

Start an aviation or air-services business

How the output is used

Use it as your first roadmap into aviation — settle the segment, the entity and the DGCA approvals you will need, then move to the full business plan.

Important cautions

Aviation is highly capital-intensive and DGCA-regulated with long, exacting approval processes; requirements vary by segment. Confirm the exact DGCA and BCAS and other approvals for your segment and budget for long timelines before committing.
