Use it to build an aviation Safety Management System (SMS) — the policy, risk process, reporting and assurance the regulator requires.

Important cautions

An SMS is a DGCA requirement across aviation operations and must be tailored and genuinely operated, not just documented. Confirm the current SMS requirements with DGCA and embed the system into daily operations.
