

BIS / ISI Quality Compliance Guide

Building Materials & Hardware

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Explains BIS/ISI mandatory certification for building materials — which products require it (cement, steel, and others under quality control orders), how to verify genuine ISI marking, avoiding counterfeit/substandard stock, and liability for selling non-compliant material. Use it to protect against fake stock and legal risk. For certifications on your own use the Trade Licensing & Registrations tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Stock and sell only compliant, genuine material

How the output is used

Use it to stock and sell only compliant, genuine material — how to check BIS/ISI marking and reject sub-standard or counterfeit stock.

Important cautions

Selling non-ISI cement/steel is illegal and dangerous, and exposes you to product-liability; verify BIS marking and buy from authorised sources only. Confirm the current mandatory-certification list.
