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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Estimates the quantity of key materials for a construction job from area/scope — cement, steel, sand, aggregate, bricks/blocks, tiles, paint — with rule-of-thumb assumptions, so you can quote and advise customers on what they need. Use it to size an order. For a formal quotation use the Quotation & Order Builder.

Purpose of this tool & output

Estimate materials for a construction job

How the output is used

Use it to estimate materials for a construction job — cement, steel, sand, aggregate, bricks and more for the built-up area, as a selling aid.

Important cautions

These are approximate thumb-rule estimates for ordering; actual quantities depend on the structural design and site — use a BOQ/engineer estimate for accuracy. Add wastage.
