Background

Drafts a transport/delivery contractor agreement with each term separate — vehicles and rates, load and safety, damage responsibility, and payment/duration — so hired delivery is reliable and damage/loss is accountable. Use it to engage transporters. For inbound freight management use the Inward Transport & Freight Management tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Engage delivery vehicles on discrete terms

How the output is used

Use the draft to engage delivery vehicles on discrete terms — rates, liability for damage in transit, insurance and documentation — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between you and the transport contractor; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually executed on stamp paper per your state; GST is handled in invoicing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the transit-damage liability, insurance and indemnity clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; fix transit damage/loss liability on the transporter and require valid permit/insurance; a lawyer should review.
