Background

Build a batch costing sheet for a chemical production batch — actual materials consumed, utilities and labour for the batch, yield and cost per kg of output — to track batch economics and variances. Enter the batch details below.

Use it to find the true cost of a specific batch — actual inputs, yield and overheads, so you know each batch profitability.

Who should vet it

Your cost accountant, to confirm the actual inputs, yield and overhead allocation in the batch cost.
