Who receives it

The local Municipal Corporation/Development Authority (and utilities for disconnection).

How to submit / file it

Apply with ownership, a structural/demolition method statement and safety plan; utility disconnections and debris (C&D waste) disposal must be arranged.

Fees & charges

Permit and C&D-waste charges per the local authority.

Who should vet it

A structural engineer for the demolition method and a safety consultant.

Important cautions
