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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Get a labour contractor agreement with compliance safeguards — a clause-by-clause draft covering scope and rates, measurement and payment, statutory compliance (PF, ESI, wages, licence), safety, indemnity for compliance and termination, with a note on Contract Labour Act and BOCW obligations. Have a lawyer review. Fill in your details below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Engage labour contractors compliantly

How the output is used

Use the draft to engage a labour contractor compliantly, fixing scope, rates, safety and statutory responsibility.

Who receives it

The principal employer/contractor and the labour contractor — both sign; a copy each.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state; the labour contractor may also need a CLRA licence where thresholds apply.

Who should vet it

A labour-law consultant or lawyer, to fix PF/ESI, wage and CLRA responsibility and indemnity.

Important cautions

AI-generated template; ensure labour-law compliance and legal review.
