Background

Get a material supply contract — a clause-by-clause draft covering material and specs, price and escalation, quantity and schedule, delivery and risk, quality and testing, payment, penalties, GST and dispute resolution, plus schedules. Have a lawyer review. Fill in your details below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Lock supply terms for key materials

How the output is used

Use the draft to lock supply terms for a key material — quantity, rate, delivery and quality — before you rely on the vendor.

Who receives it

The buyer (contractor/developer) and the material supplier — both sign; a copy each.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state; GST applies on the material invoices.

Who should vet it

A contracts lawyer, for the price-variation, rejection and delivery-default clauses.

Important cautions

AI-generated template; have it reviewed by a lawyer before signing.
