

Client Contract Review

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Paste a client contract or MSA and get a risk review — flagged concerns by clause area (payment, liability, IP, indemnity, termination, non-compete), red flags, and negotiation points. This is a review, not legal advice; have a lawyer review before you sign. To draft your own agreement instead, use the Service Agreement or MSA tools. Fill in your details below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Spot risky terms before you sign

How the output is used

Use the review to spot risky terms in a client contract before you sign — liability, IP, indemnity and payment.

Who receives it

For your internal use and your lawyer; the client is not a recipient of the review.

Fees & charges

No government fee for the review; a lawyer charges a professional fee for a formal opinion.

Who should vet it

A commercial lawyer, for the liability cap, IP and indemnity clauses.

Important cautions

AI-generated review, not legal advice; have a lawyer review before signing.
