Background

Draft a Master Services Agreement — the framework that governs an ongoing client relationship, with individual SOWs sitting under it. Covers scope, fees, IP, confidentiality, liability cap, term and termination, non-solicit and dispute resolution. For a single fixed project use the Service Agreement instead. Have it reviewed by a lawyer before signing. Fill in your details below.

Purpose of this tool & output

A strong framework agreement with clients

How the output is used

Use the draft for a strong master services agreement (MSA) framework with clients before individual SOWs.

Who receives it

The firm and the client — both sign; a copy each.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state; GST applies on the services (export of services may be zero-rated with LUT).

Who should vet it

A commercial lawyer, for the liability cap, IP, indemnity and termination clauses.

Important cautions

AI-generated template; have it reviewed by a lawyer before signing.
