## Background

Produces a guide to recognising and responding to common livestock diseases — symptoms, immediate action, isolation, and when to call the vet — for your animal type, so outbreaks are caught early and losses minimised. Use it as a farm health reference. For prevention use the Vaccination & Health Calendar tool.

## Purpose of this tool & output

Recognise and respond to common diseases

## How the output is used

Use it to recognise and respond to common diseases — the signs, first steps and when to call the vet, so problems are caught early.

## Important cautions

This is a reference for early recognition and first response — serious cases need a qualified veterinarian; do not self-medicate (esp. antibiotics — milk withdrawal and resistance). Report notifiable/zoonotic diseases (FMD, bird flu, brucellosis) to authorities.
