

Farm Feasibility Study

Dairy, Poultry & Livestock

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Analyses whether a specific farm plan is viable — production and price, feed and input cost, mortality/risk, market linkage and break-even — with a go/no-go, so you commit capital wisely. Use it before starting/expanding. For the full plan use the Farm Business Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

Check if the farm will actually pay

How the output is used

Use it as a go/no-go check before you invest — does the yield, milk price and feed cost leave a real profit at your herd size.

Who should vet it

A veterinary or dairy-development officer, or an experienced farmer, to sanity-check the yield and feed-cost assumptions against local reality.

Important cautions

Estimate; confirm real yields (not seller claims), feed cost and market price, and stress-test for a disease/mortality event and a price dip. Reliable market linkage is essential.
