Background

Drafts a farm-worker employment agreement with discrete terms — role, wages, hours, housing, leave, duties and termination. Use it to employ workers on record. For labour-law rules use the Farm Labour Compliance Guide (D10).

Purpose of this tool & output

Hire dairy/farm workers on clear terms

How the output is used

Use the draft to hire dairy or farm workers on clear terms — role, wages, hours, accommodation and duties — reviewed for local labour law.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the farm and the worker; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually executed on nominal stamp paper per your state; no heavy stamp duty for a simple worker agreement.

Who should vet it

A labour-law consultant or lawyer, to align the wages, hours and terms with the applicable labour laws.

Important cautions

Template for guidance, not legal advice. Pay at least the applicable state minimum wage and follow labour norms. Keep wage records. Have the terms checked locally before use.
