

Farm Land Lease Agreement

Dairy, Poultry & Livestock

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a farm land lease with discrete terms — parcel, use, rent and escalation, deposit, term, lock-in and structures. Use it to lease land for a dairy/poultry/fodder operation. Fill each term separately.

Purpose of this tool & output

Lease land for a dairy/poultry farm

How the output is used

Use the draft to lease land for a dairy or poultry farm — rent, tenure, permitted use and exit — then have a lawyer review and register it.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the landowner and you as the tenant; each keeps a signed copy, and the registered copy is the legal record.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty and registration charges per your state, based on rent and tenure; a lease beyond the notified term must be registered.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to confirm the permitted use for a farm, the tenure, exit and the registration requirement.

Important cautions

Template for guidance, not legal advice. Building non-agricultural structures on agricultural land may need conversion/permission — verify local land-use rules. Register the lease as required and have a lawyer review.
