Background

Guides mineral and supplement management — the role of mineral mixture, calcium/phosphorus, salt and vitamins, deficiency signs (infertility, poor yield, milk fever), and correct supplementation — so hidden deficiencies do not silently cap fertility, health and milk. Use it to supplement right. For the ration use the Feed & Ration Planning tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Fix the deficiencies that limit health and yield

How the output is used

Use it to fix the deficiencies that limit health and yield — the mineral and supplement plan for your feed and region.

Important cautions

Hidden mineral deficiencies silently cause infertility, milk fever and low yield; a daily balanced mineral mixture and salt are cheap insurance. Manage calcium around calving to prevent milk fever. Consult your vet for area-specific deficiencies and dosing.
