How the output is used

Use it for FSSAI-compliant packaging and labels — the mandatory declarations and packaging your dairy products must carry.

Important cautions

Label declarations are mandatory under FSSAI and Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities) rules — display the FSSAI licence number, veg mark, net quantity, MRP and best-before correctly. Verify current label requirements before printing.
