Background

Produces a disease-compliance guide for poultry/livestock — notifiable diseases, reporting duties, vaccination and biosecurity obligations, and outbreak protocol. Use it to meet animal-disease rules and act right in an outbreak. For a routine vaccination plan use the Vaccination Calendar (D3).

Purpose of this tool & output

Disease reporting, biosecurity and vaccination law

How the output is used

Use it to meet disease reporting, biosecurity and vaccination law — the poultry and livestock health obligations that apply to your unit.

Important cautions

Suspected notifiable diseases (bird flu, FMD, etc.) must be reported to the veterinary/animal-husbandry authority — concealment is illegal and a public-health risk. Follow official containment and disposal orders. Confirm current notifiable-disease and reporting rules locally.
