Background

Builds a plan to raise milk yield per animal — nutrition/ration balancing, comfort and heat management, milking and health/mastitis control, breeding and culling low-yielders — so you produce more milk from the same herd cost. Use it when yields are low. For nutrition use the Feed & Ration Planning tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Raise milk per animal profitably

How the output is used

Use it to raise milk per animal profitably — the feeding, health and management levers that lift yield without raising cost per litre.

Important cautions

Ration balancing and cow comfort are usually the biggest under-used yield levers; raise yield only where the extra feed/input pays back. Cull persistently low-yielders eating full feed — they lose money.
