Designs a sample cold-chain and transport system — temperature requirements, packing, routing, timing and monitoring — from collection points to the lab. Use it to protect sample integrity. For routing use the Sample Logistics & Routing Plan.

How the output is used

Use it to move samples without spoiling them — a sample cold-chain and transport setup that protects sample integrity to the lab.

Important cautions

Most lab errors are pre-analytical — wrong temperature, delay or bad packing spoils samples silently and produces wrong results. Use triple packaging and biohazard labelling for infectious substances and monitor temperature. Define and enforce sample-rejection criteria.
