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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Designs an organisation structure for a diagnostic centre — signatory, technical, phlebotomy, front office, accounts and quality roles with reporting lines. Use it to staff and delegate. For hiring sequence use the Lab Staffing & Hiring Plan.

How the output is used

Use it to design roles and reporting for a lab — technicians, phlebotomists, front desk and signatory, so quality and compliance have clear owners.

Important cautions

The pathology or radiology signatory must be genuinely qualified and actually responsible for reports — name-lending is illegal and unsafe. NABL and quality roles become important as you scale and pursue accreditation.
