Who receives it

The scholarship-granting department/ministry, via the National Scholarship Portal (NSP).

How to submit / file it

Apply on scholarships.gov.in within the scheme window with Aadhaar, income/caste and bank details; the institute verifies the application.

Who should vet it

The institute nodal officer, who verifies and forwards the NSP application.

Important cautions
