Background

Explains BIS and the Compulsory Registration Scheme (CRS) for electronics — which products need BIS/CRS registration and marking, the dealer duty to sell only registered/compliant goods, avoiding non-compliant/grey-market stock, and the liability — so you do not sell illegal, non-compliant electronics. Use it to check compliance. For registrations use the Registrations & Licences Guide.

Purpose of this tool & output

Sell only BIS-registered compliant products

How the output is used

Use it to sell only BIS-registered compliant products — how to check the BIS/CRS registration of electronics so you avoid non-compliant stock.

Important cautions

Selling non-BIS-registered/grey-market electronics is illegal and unsafe and exposes the dealer to penalties and seizure; buy from authorised sources and check BIS marking. Confirm the current CRS mandatory-product list.
