Background

Explains Legal Metrology compliance for an electronics dealer — MRP display and no-selling-above-MRP, packaged-declaration requirements, and price display — so you avoid weights-and-measures/MRP complaints. Use it for MRP/pricing compliance. For registrations use the Registrations & Licences Guide.

Purpose of this tool & output

Stay right on MRP and declarations

How the output is used

Use it to stay right on MRP and declarations — the Legal Metrology and packaged-goods rules that apply to what you sell.

Important cautions

Selling above the printed MRP is illegal and a frequent complaint on scarce/hot items; sell at or below MRP and ensure products carry proper declarations. Confirm current Legal Metrology rules.
