Background

Builds a multi-store operations framework — centralised purchasing and inventory sharing, consistent pricing and SOPs, store performance comparison, stock-transfer between stores, and central MIS — so multiple stores run consistently and leverage scale. Use it when running several stores. For expansion strategy use the Store Expansion Strategy tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

How the output is used

Use it to run several stores consistently — a multi-store operations approach for stock, pricing, service and reporting across locations.

Important cautions

Multi-store scale helps through central purchasing and stock-sharing (move slow stock to where it sells before it obsolesces); enforce consistent pricing/SOPs and compare stores, with a central MIS for control.
