Background

Maps the registrations and licences an electronics/appliance business needs — GST, Shops & Establishment, Udyam, trade licence — and flags product-compliance obligations (BIS/CRS, BEE, e-waste EPR) that apply to what you sell. Use it to map compliance. For the calendar use the Compliance Calendar.

Important cautions

Product certification (BIS/CRS, BEE) is mainly the manufacturer/importer duty, but dealers must sell only compliant, labelled goods and meet e-waste collection duties. Confirm current requirements with a CA/consultant.
