

Service / ASC Franchise Agreement

Consumer Electronics & Appliances

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a service/franchise agreement (running a branded/authorised service centre or franchising your service brand) with each term separate — scope and standards, payouts/fees, parts/warranty, technician certification, SLAs, and term — so service arrangements are clear and quality-bound. Use it for service franchise/ASC terms. For the service setup use the Service Centre Setup tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Structure a service or ASC arrangement

How the output is used

Use the draft to structure a service or ASC arrangement — scope, standards, parts, warranty responsibility and fees — then have a lawyer review it.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the brand or principal and the service centre; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state stamp act; GST is handled in invoicing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the warranty-responsibility, parts, liability and termination clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; ASC/service-franchise arrangements hinge on quality standards, SLAs and payout economics — clarify these and have a lawyer review.
