Background

Identifies every approval an energy project needs — land use, grid connectivity, CEI electrical, environmental, DISCOM/state nodal, pollution and fire — with the authority and when each is needed, in a logical sequence. Use this as your master approvals checklist. For a specific approval, use the dedicated CEIG, Environmental Clearance or DISCOM tools.

Use it to list every approval your project needs — CEIG, DISCOM/nodal, environmental, land, grid — with the sequence and who issues each.

Who should vet it

An energy consultant or electrical engineer, to confirm the exact approval set for your project size, technology and state.
