

Solar EPC Contract

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts an India-oriented solar EPC contract — a clause-by-clause draft covering scope and specs, generation (PR) guarantee, price and payment, timeline and liquidated damages, quality and warranties, O&M, safety, insurance, termination and dispute resolution, plus the key schedules. Use this to paper a solar project. Have it reviewed by a lawyer before signing.

Purpose of this tool & output

A solid EPC agreement for solar projects

How the output is used

Use the draft as the basis for a solar EPC deal — scope, PR guarantee, price, timeline, LDs, warranties and O&M — then have a lawyer review it before signing.

Who receives it

The project owner and the EPC contractor who sign it, each keeping a stamped copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty on the contract value per your state stamp act; GST is handled in invoicing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer — to check the liability cap, the PR/generation guarantee, the LD and the termination clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated template; have it reviewed by a lawyer before signing.
