

Consent Application Kit

Environment & Waste Management

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Get a documentation kit for an SPCB consent application — the forms, technical details, pollution-control and layout documents, and fees — so the CTE/CTO application is complete and not returned. Describe the unit below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Assemble a complete consent application

How the output is used

Use it to assemble a complete consent application — the documents, effluent/emission details and treatment plan the SPCB requires for CTE or CTO.

Who receives it

The application is filed with the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) on its consent portal, for Consent to Establish or Consent to Operate.

How to submit / file it

File the project, effluent/emission, treatment and layout details with the prescribed fees on the SPCB portal; the Board scrutinises and may inspect before granting consent.

Fees & charges

A consent fee based on the project cost and category, set by the state; consent is granted for a fixed validity and renewed.

Who should vet it

The SPCB officers who scrutinise and inspect, with an environmental consultant preparing the application and treatment design.
