

Consent Renewal Guide

Background

Get a guide to renewing SPCB Consent to Operate — timelines, documents, compliance status and monitoring data needed, and how to handle changes in production or conditions — so consent stays valid. Describe the situation below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Renew CTO on time, avoid closure risk

How the output is used

Use it to renew the CTO on time and avoid closure risk — the renewal filing, updated data and fees the SPCB needs before expiry.

Who receives it

The renewal application goes to the State Pollution Control Board that issued the consent, on its consent portal.

How to submit / file it

File the renewal before expiry with updated production, effluent, emission and treatment-performance data and monitoring results, along with the renewal fee.

Fees & charges

A renewal consent fee based on the project cost and category; a lapse can attract closure or penalty action.

Who should vet it

The SPCB, which reviews the compliance and monitoring record before renewing, with a consultant compiling the data.

Important cautions

AI-generated guide; apply well before expiry - operating without valid consent is an offence.
