Background

Get an energy audit framework and analysis for a facility — energy balance and benchmarks, saving opportunities across systems (motors, HVAC, lighting, compressed air, thermal), and savings/payback — to reduce energy cost and carbon. Describe the facility below.

Use it to find and cost energy-saving opportunities — an energy audit that quantifies use, losses and the savings each measure delivers.

Who should vet it

A BEE-accredited energy auditor, to validate the findings and savings before you commit capital or claim them.

Important cautions

AI-generated audit; validate with metered data; statutory energy audits need an accredited/BEE-certified auditor.
