

EPR Registration Kit

Environment & Waste Management

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Get a documentation and step kit to register as a producer/importer/brand-owner on the CPCB EPR portal for a waste stream — documents, data to compile, and the process — so registration goes through. Describe the registration below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Register on the CPCB EPR portal

How the output is used

Use it to register on the CPCB EPR portal — the producer/importer/recycler registration that unlocks EPR obligations and credits.

Who receives it

The registration is done on the CPCB EPR portal (for plastic, e-waste, battery or tyre/oil as applicable), under the Central Pollution Control Board.

How to submit / file it

Create the entity account, submit the company, product/material and quantity details with the prescribed documents, and obtain the EPR registration certificate.

Fees & charges

A CPCB registration/processing fee that varies by category and quantity; the registration is periodically renewed.

Who should vet it

The CPCB, which validates the registration; an EPR consultant usually compiles the data and category mapping.
