

Waste Authorisation Application Kit

Environment & Waste Management

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Get a documentation kit to apply for authorisation under the Hazardous/Other Waste Rules (generator, recycler, TSDF, or transporter) — the forms, data and documents needed and the process — so the application is complete. Describe the applicant below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Get hazardous/other-waste authorisation

How the output is used

Use it to get hazardous or other-waste authorisation — the SPCB authorisation a generator, transporter, recycler or TSDF must hold.

Who receives it

The authorisation is granted by the State Pollution Control Board under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules.

How to submit / file it

Apply to the SPCB with the waste-category and quantity, storage, disposal arrangement (TSDF/recycler tie-up) and manifest system, and obtain the authorisation before handling.

Fees & charges

An SPCB authorisation fee based on category and quantity; the authorisation is periodically renewed.

Who should vet it

The SPCB, which verifies the storage, disposal tie-up and records; an environmental consultant usually prepares the application.

Important cautions
