

Police NOC Application Kit

Events, Weddings & Entertainment

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Get a preparation kit for a police NOC/permission for a public event — the application, documents, safety and crowd plan attachments, and undertakings typically needed — so your submission is complete. Describe the event below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Prepare a strong police-permission file

How the output is used

Use it to prepare a strong police-permission file — the application and documents for the police NOC a public event needs.

Who receives it

The application goes to the local police (the jurisdictional police station or the DCP/Commissionerate), depending on the event and venue.

How to submit / file it

Apply well in advance with the event details, venue, expected crowd, timing, security and safety arrangements, and other NOCs (fire, venue) as required; the police may inspect before granting the NOC.

Fees & charges

Usually no or a nominal fee for the police NOC; the real cost is the security and safety arrangements the police require.

Who should vet it

The local police, who assess the crowd, security and safety plan before granting the permission.

Important cautions
