Background

Builds a farm-level biosecurity plan — entry control, water and equipment hygiene, crab and bird barriers, seed screening and zoning — to prevent disease outbreaks. Use it to protect a farm.

Purpose of this tool & output

Keep disease out of the farm

How the output is used

Use it to keep disease out of the farm — a farm biosecurity plan across entry control, disinfection and carrier management.

Important cautions

Biosecurity reduces but cannot eliminate disease risk, especially with shared water sources; white spot and other pathogens spread fast. Use screened seed, maintain reservoirs and consult a fish-health specialist at the first sign of disease.
