

Seafood Export Readiness Assessment

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Assesses readiness to export seafood — registrations, plant approval, HACCP, residue control, buyers and finance — and gives a gap-closing roadmap. Use it before committing to export.

Purpose of this tool & output

Check if you are ready to export

How the output is used

Use it to check if you are ready to export — a seafood export readiness assessment across registration, HACCP, residue and documentation.

Who should vet it

An export consultant, to confirm the readiness gaps and corrective steps before you take an export order.

Important cautions

Market-specific requirements (EU, US FDA, others) are detailed and change and approval takes time; residue control is decisive. Confirm current requirements with MPEDA and the EIA and validate buyers before investing in export.
