

Seed & Fingerling Sourcing Guide

Fisheries & Aquaculture

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Guides sourcing of quality fish seed or shrimp post-larvae — hatchery selection, quality and disease screening, acclimatisation and transport — the single biggest determinant of a crop. Use it before stocking.

Purpose of this tool & output

Source quality seed and post-larvae

How the output is used

Use it to source quality seed and post-larvae — a seed and fingerling sourcing guide across health, PCR screening and hatchery reputation.

Important cautions

Seed quality decides the crop and cannot be corrected later; cheap or unscreened seed is a false economy. Insist on PCR or SPF documentation for shrimp and test a sample before accepting a large lot.
