

Fisheries Business Setup Guide

Fisheries & Aquaculture

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a setup plan for a fisheries or aquaculture business — model, species, farming or capture or processing, registrations and a launch checklist. Use it to start out. For a funding document use the Fisheries Business Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

Start a fisheries or aquaculture business

How the output is used

Use it as your starting roadmap — pick the model, confirm the registrations for your model and state, line up the water/site and inputs, and work through the launch checklist before stocking.

Important cautions

Aquaculture carries biological risk (disease, water quality, mortality) and a full crop cycle before revenue; coastal and brackish-water farms need Coastal Aquaculture Authority registration and CRZ compliance. Confirm registrations for your model, species and state, and validate water and market before stocking.
